Information and Rules

The program will run during the school year from August until June.

Each 3rd grader and each new 4th-5th grader will receive an OMS carabiner. Returning 4th and 5th graders were given carabiners as 3rd graders.

To earn a tag:

1.) Read **3** books from the same category. Categories are as follows:

Fantasy
Historical Fiction
Mystery
Non-Fiction
Realistic Fiction
Readers Choice

OR...

- 2.) Read 4 books from the **Award Books** category.
(When you earn an Award Books tag, you will be eligible to vote for the Illinois Bluestem Award book! To vote, you must read the 5 books by March.)
- 3.) Record your reading on colored Get Tagged forms available in the LMC. Have an adult (parent/teacher) sign your form after you have finished reading a book.
- 4.) Place your finished form (with your full name) in bin in LMC.

Tags will be delivered once the forms are processed.

*****Please try at least 3 categories before you repeat one.**

*You can earn **2 tags** in any one category.

*Books should be **age-appropriate**, not too easy.

*A **read-aloud** at home is OK. Audiobooks count as well.

*These should be **new reads**. Do not record a book that you read before the program started.

Fantasy Books:

Fantasy books have strange or other worldly settings or characters. Magic, time travel, and talking animals may be included.

Mystery Books:

Mystery books are suspenseful stories about a puzzling event that is not solved until the end of the story.

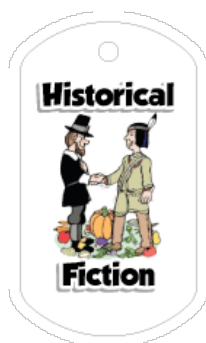
Read 3 to earn this tag.



Non-Fiction Books

These are books that are based on facts, real events, and real people, such as biography or history. Informational books about topics are popular types of books to use for this tag.

Read 3 to earn this tag.



Historical Fiction Books:

Historical fiction books are stories with fictional characters that are set in a certain period of history.

Read 3 to earn this tag.



Realistic Fiction Books:

Realistic fiction books are stories that can actually happen and are true to life.

Read 3 to earn this tag.



Reader's Choice Books:

This can be a combination of any of the types of books listed on this form or other genres. You may also read graphic novels and science fiction books for this tag. For example, you might read one mystery, one graphic novel, and one fantasy.
